Literacy – year 1

- 1) Look at the features of a non - fiction book and compare it to a story.
- 2) Look in a book and find some examples of apostrophes that are contractions – e.g don't , she'll , haven't.
Write them down as two words followed by the shortened version e.g. did not – didn't
- 3) We have been working on describing dinosaurs at school. Find some describing words in your story books at home. You could also write a list of describing words about the snow in your garden and then see if you can use each word by writing it down within a sentence!
- 4) Find out some dinosaur facts and write them down. You all wanted to know why dinosaurs became extinct! See if you can find out some answers!

Maths year 1

Count on and back from any number up to 100.

Write your numbers to 20 in words – e.g. one, two.

Practise counting in 2s 5s and 10s.

Do some takeaway number sentences to 50 by counting back . e.g $35 - 7 = 28$ Put 35 in your head, hold up 7 fingers, start counting back with 34 as you put down a finger and so on.

- 1) Look at a non fiction book and compare it to a story
- 2) Draw a picture of the snow and write some describing words about the snow.
- 3) Find out some dinosaur facts!
- 4) Write down some words which have the sounds ch sh th ng and qu in them. How many can you think of?
- 5) Go on phonics play website and choose phase 3 - play Picnic on Pluto.

Maths EYFS

- 1) Count up to at least 20 – or more if you can!
- 2) Write the numbers to 20.
- 3) Draw 20 snowflakes or snowballs!
- 4) Practise taking away – use sweets if you are lucky ! Count some out , then take some away by eating them! Count how many you have left. See if you can write that number down.
