

COVID 19 Contingency Plan

Fingringhoe C of E Primary School



Courage. Care. Compassion.

If there is the need for a whole school closure, or in the event of a Bubble closing in order to self-isolate, then there will be the need to return to a remote education offer. Teachers will provide a weeks' worth of planning within 24 hours of closure. The planning will include Maths and English tasks as a priority, with three project-based activities linked to other subjects. Work will be set, shared and marked on DB Primary. It is parental responsibility to ensure there is access to this facility.

Teachers will access the DB Primary work daily between 9am and 1pm. This is the time they will also check and respond to any email messages via DB Primary. Teachers will provide one Zoom a week (date and time set by individual teachers with link via DBP) lasting approximately 45 minutes, in order to retain the bond between pupils in the class Bubble. This time can also be used to ask questions and share work ideas.

If a Class Teacher is unwell, then another member of staff will stand in for them for a Zoom Meet and work will be set by a member of the Key Stage appropriate Team. Pupils are expected to work for at least 2 hours a day at home.

Tasks to complete include:

1. Daily Maths task
2. Daily English task (writing, grammar, spelling, comprehension)
3. Daily Phonics for Reception and KS1 classes
4. Three foundation subject activities per week (Science, History, Geography, French, RE, Art, PSHCE, DT & Music)
5. Reading 4 times a week
6. Times Table revision 2 x week

Pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6 may also be allocated tasks via the CPG books, which will be monitored by their class teachers once a week. Pupils in Years 2 & 6 may be given further revision work to prepare them for end of Key Stage assessments, including SATs tests.

Individual isolation

For pupils self-isolating but not as part of a full bubble closure, schoolwork will be set by the class teacher within 24 hours of the first day of isolation- via DB Primary. The Teacher or LSA will check work and provide feedback frequently, but this may not be daily. There will be no zoom meet for individual pupils not in school. Immediate work set will be through the expectation that in addition to reading, the child will access our remote learning platforms:

- Times Table Rock Stars
- Phonics Play (EYFS and KS1)
