Willow

Maple class have just finished a unit of Art where they have been learning how to use charcoal. They began by learning about artists who use charcoal, they practised how to use the media and then they explored chiaroscuro (how to use light and dark to create atmosphere).

Their final piece was to draw an object, in the dark, using a torch to create a shadow to draw. They really enjoyed it!


We then asked the rest of the school to visit us to show off our learning. Maple class really enjoyed discussing their learning with their peers.



Elm

On Tuesday 26th November, Elm Class were treated to an assembly by someone who works for the UK Parliament Education Team. The assembly was about how Parliament works, including how a new law is accepted, how a party may lead the government, what an MP is, and how to be more involved in the future.

In lessons recently, the children have been writing up Diary Entries from the Battle of Hastings, using multiplication and division to work out multi-step problems, understanding the history of the Hagia Sophia in R.E., and binary addition in Computing.
